Dressage Test for Intro Level will be: NZPCA Junior Riding Test "M" 2001

Team entries close on the official entry form with entry fee of \$15 per rider to the Area Event Secretary:
Jan Stradwick, PO Box 196, Kaukapakapa, 0843 by 6pm on Wednesday, 3rd March, 2010.

NO PHONE ENTRIES LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

1. Riders must be under 21 years as at the day of competition.
2. Riders may not be competing at Area Trials in the current season.
3. Riders must not have won their way out of this level.
4. The combination must be eligible to compete at the level being ridden on the day of competition. The NZPCA Working Rally and Attendance at Rallies will apply to all riders.
5. Four or Five riders per team. One team per level per Club/District. Clubs that are unable to field a full team may, in consultation with the DC from another Club within W/R Area, co-opt into their team a combination that has taken part in the club selection but has not been chosen for the team for that other club. All 4 scores to count in the dressage phase and 3 overall. Rosettes will be presented for both dressage and overall team placings 1st - 4th inclusive.
6. Run under NZPCA rules. Heights etc. to conform to NZPCA rules for Introductory level.
7. No callers for the dressage phase.
8. Club/District uniform to be worn in all phases - no jackets to be worn for dressage or show jumping. Uniform must have long sleeves.
9. Protests may only be made by the Team Manager and should be in writing with \$30 deposit which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
10. All riders must be present, correctly attired & mounted for the prizegiving or, at the discretion of the nominated representative of the Area Committee present, placings and rosettes may be forfeited.
11. A copy of the team draw will be sent to the Team Manager no more than 4 days from the close of entries. It is your Team Manager's responsibility to advise your riders of their draw numbers.
12. Clubs are required to provide 3 cross country jump judges, per team. Please include their names on the space provided on the entry form.
13. All riders will ride in succession for all phases as a team in all 3 phases, according to the Draw.
14. All riders will need to complete a gear check before riding each phase. Failure to do so will result in elimination of that rider.
15. All team riders must compete 1st before any other competitors riding in the same event.

AREA TEAMS HORSE TRIAL - LIST OF RESPONSIBILITIES

HOST

Provide one dressage arena.

Provide 1 dressage judge, to be approved by Area at January meeting

Arrange St Johns, Doctor and Vet on call.

Supply 1 writer and 1 gate steward for dressage.

Write up dressage sheets with back number and District/Club name only

Supply back numbers and provide stopwatches

Provide an experienced S/J judge, to be approved by Area at January meeting.

Provide scoreboard for teams' event.

Provide scorers for team competition.

Prepare programme of event and distribute at course walk.

Arrange official X/C course walk and advise Area Event Secretary.

Provide catering for Area Officials, Dressage Judges, Showjumping Judge, Chief X/C Judge and TD.

Appoint Chief Cross Country Judge and T.D. for December meeting.

Provide quiet area for scorers separate from other facilities.

AREA MEETINGS

Rules Sub-committee to set dressage tests.

At January meeting, Approve of 1 dressage judge

At January meeting, appoint Appeals Committee of 3 members, to be nominated

Area rosettes for team winners 1st to 4th for Dressage and Overall team placings.

Event Secretary to receive all entry fees paid.

Pay dressage and Showjumping Judges.

Pay host Club \$100 catering allowance

Events Secretary to make draw and send to Team Managers and host Club with X/C course walk time.
