AREA TEAMS SHOW JUMPING COMPETITION

Age groups: 13 & under, 14 - 16 years, 17 - 21 years.
Ages as at the date of Competition

Maximum heights for each first round.	75cm.	85cm	90cm
Maximum heights for the competition	85cm	95cm	100cm

Maximum of two teams per Club. (Riders must be financial members of NZPCA).

1. Teams are made up of 6 riders - 2 in each age group. Riders may ride up an age group if insufficient riders are available; however riders who ride up in the 17 - 21 year's age group must be on hacks. Clubs that are unable to field a full team may, with the approval of the DC from another Club within Waitemata Rodney Area Pony Club; co-opt into their team a combination that has taken part in the Club selection but has not been chosen for the team for their own Club.
2. A rider shall be eligible to ride in one age group only,
3. If a Team rider has more than one horse entered on the day, they must ride their nominated team horse first.
4. In each age group the riders scoring the highest points shall be awarded Champion and Reserve sashes.
5. Rules & Regulations for Areas, Clubs & Branches: Rule 2:19 – Working Rallies, and 2:20 – Attendance at Rallies applies to all team riders.
6. Club colours to be worn by the teams.

Programme: AM5 (1 round plus 1 jump-off against the clock)
AM4 (1 round time allowed. First jump-off time allowed.
Second jump-off against the clock)
Accumulator Competition (refer FEI Showjumping Rule Book, Article 269).

Scoring: Team riders' scores are extracted from the judges' sheets and points are allocated to the top 10 eligible team riders.

7. There will be a compulsory gear check at the GATE, of each ring. Before the beginning your first round, Team managers are to take all team riders helmets and present them at the time of collecting back numbers.

8. All riders may ride as Individuals at this event, (A separate entry fee is payable on the day)

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AREA TEAMS SHOWJUMPING - LIST OF RESPONSIBILITIES

HOST

Provide 3 rings for the Area Competition rounds with judges, course planner / builder to be approved by Area in February meeting.

Host Club/District to measure course and calculate time.

Should the Host Club wish to hold other competitions; these must be in separate arenas and run after Area Team riders in each class.

Host Club to arrange advertising, entries etc. for the competitions held in conjunction with the Area Teams event.

Provide individual placings rosettes.

Provide order of riders to team managers

Provide a Gate Keeper to Gear Checker at the gate & 1 helper at each arena.

Supply scorer for Team's competition, and provide quiet area for scorers separate from other facilities.

Arrange St Johns (or qualified first aider), Doctor, Vet on call.

Advise Area Event Secretary of list of facilities, catering etc

Arrange catering for judges etc. & Area Officials.

Have a pool of manpower for altering jumps

AREA

February meeting: Approve judges, course planner / builder

Supply rosettes for each team placings 1st to 4th inclusive. Each age group the Champion and Reserve sashes.

Supply minimum 2 scorers. At least one scorer should be from the next hosting club.

February meeting: Appoint an Appeals Committee of 3 members and supply them with a job description.

Pay the judges / course designer expenses where necessary.

Pay host Club \$100 catering allowance

Teams, furthest from venue not to ride first.
