AREA INTERCLUB - GAMES (INCA CUP)

This will be held on Monday, 5th April, 2010 at Massey Pony Club, 10am start.

Entry Fee of \$90 per Team (6) and / or \$15 per Rider.
NO LATE ENTRIES or PHONE ENTRIES

Age: under 21 as at date of competition. Ages are: 13 & under, 14 to 16, 17 and under 21.

Two riders in each Age group. A reserve for each age group should also be named.

Each Club can send any number of teams.

A Club may send a partial team of one or more age groups.

All riders may ride as an individual.

No maximum number of Teams per Club.

The NZPCA Rules for Clubs and Branches rule: 2:19 Working Rallies applies, and also rule 2:20 Attendance at Rallies applies. Note the new rules that cover what events may be classed as a rally.
Club uniform is to be worn by all riders.

1. Saddlery as per NZPCA Mounted Games Book.
2. Games will be decided annually, (rules in NZPCA Mounted Games Book).
3. All games at this day will be run for individuals.
4. All age groups to provide one helper i.e. Lane Judge or Timekeeper (preferably an experienced person).

The helper MUST report for judges' brief at 9.00am.

5. One horse per rider. One rider per horse.
6. Scoring - for each game and will be as for the rules in the NZPCA Mounted Games book, modified for individuals.
Scoring for the team - one rider from each age group plus the best other score to count.
A mounted prizegiving will be held with Rosettes for the Teams placed 1st to 4th.
In each age group the riders scoring the highest points shall be awarded Champion and Reserve sashes
All riders must be present, correctly attired in Club uniform and mounted for the prizegiving, unless they have the permission from the nominated representatives of the Area Committee present to leave the competition.

Rosettes will be awarded to the INDIVIDUALS in each age group, placed 1st to 4th.

7. A Gear Check will take place before the first game starts. 9.00am Start
Team Managers should bring the FULL Team together to Gear Check.
Individuals need to complete Gear Check before the first game starts,

AREA INCA CUP SELECTION - LIST OF RESPONSIBILITIES

DISTRICT / CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES

To supply and set up equipment for all games. Host Club to confer with other Clubs re equipment and confirm in February meeting

Provide quiet area for scorers separate from other facilities.

Provide necessary helpers, timekeepers etc. to run the games.

Provide refreshments for Area Officials

Arrange St Johns (or qualified first aider), Doctor, Vet on call, farrier.

Provide a flat, safe venue that can take five lanes.

Provide trainee scorers

Provide Gear checkers

Advise Area Event Secretary of list of facilities, catering etc.

Rosettes for the INDIVIDUALS

AREA RESPONSIBILITIES

Secretary to provide printed certificates for 1st - 5th in each event final.

Secretary to provide rosettes for 1st to 4th Individuals, per age group (x 12) & 1st to 4th overall for Teams, In each age group the riders scoring the highest points shall each receive a Champion and Reserve sashes

To advise games to be run by November meeting.

Provide a teams scoreboard and score sheets.

Provide stopwatches.

Provide scorers for both team competition & selection of the Inca Cup Team.

Event Secretary to receive all entry fees paid.

Individual scoring - each individual game 1st - 10th inclusive awarded points (1st = 10 etc)
In the event of equals, place points added together & divided by number of placings.

To appoint Chief Judge and Official Steward for the competition at February meeting.

Area Treasurer to pay catering allowance of \$100.

Event Secretary to advise Chairman of team members one week before competition.
