

GRAZING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Horses must be checked a minimum of four times a week. (Please let grazing manager know days of attendance.)
Phone numbers must be painted on each horses cover
- 2 All grazers must notify a Grazing Manager when a horse will be removed overnight or longer
- 3 Application for grazing must be in writing with references to the Grazing Manager, and handed into committee members on Enrolment Day
- 4 All grazers must be financial members. This is not an acceptance of grazing rights.
- 5 There is to be no riding in Pony Club grounds whilst working bees are in progress, unless prior arrangement has been made with the Grazing Manager, President or the event organisers of the day.
- 6 The "GROUNDS CLOSED" sign is to be adhered to at all times. We ask that you exercise your discretion when using the grounds and that you refrain from driving vehicles, jumping horses and or riding in general when conditions are adverse due to weather.
- 7 No person may interfere with any other grazers' horse/s on Club grounds except with permission of the owner, but are expected to contact the grazing manager and owner if a horse/pony is injured or distressed.
- 8 All horses grazing on Club grounds are to be drenched for worms at regular intervals or when deemed necessary by the Grazing Manager, grazers must be present. At the start of each season new horses will be required to be wormed in the presence of the grazing manager or with a certified individual.
- 9 Grazing fees of \$100 are to be paid ONE MONTH in advance on the 5th of every month, payment of grazing money must be by automatic payment.
- 10 Grazer's horses must be placed where the Grazing Manager deems fit. Grazers must be available to move their horses when requested. Grazers are not allowed to change paddocks, or put up pens, at their own discretion.
- 11 Grazers are to check and clean the water troughs on a regular basis (see grazing managers roster) and report immediately any damaged fences, troughs or other equipment to a committee member.
- 12 In cases of emergency a vet may be summoned by the Grazing Manager and these costs are the sole responsibility of the grazer. All grazers must have a contact telephone number visible and available to each pony club grazer.
- 13 It is a privilege to graze on Pony Club grounds and it is in the best interest of all grazers that each and every one of you ensures the safety and welfare of all horses grazing. If there is a problem at any time DO NOT hesitate to contact the Grazing Manager or any other committee member.
- 14 ALL grazers must attend 75% of available rallies mounted unless a vet or medical certificate is supplied.
- 15 Attendance at working bees is mandatory.
- 16 The removal of dung shall be done as and when requested and the arena kept clean at all times.
- 17 Horses under four years of age, stallions, rigs or mares and foals may not be grazed on Pony Club grounds.
- 18 Any horse deemed to be extremely troublesome or a danger to other grazers, horses or people will be removed with instant termination of grazer's rights.
- 19 Horses must be penned or moved to the allocated paddock on Tues/Wed night before rallies. Plum tree/ Reserve paddock needs to be accessible for games rally on Monday. (grazing manager to co-ordinate)

- 20 Support friendliness and respect for other members is expected at all times. Negative unfriendly and antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 21 Dogs must be kept under control and away from the clubhouse. Any complaint about a dog will lead to the dog being banned from the grounds. No dogs at rallies or events. All dog poo to be removed by owner.
- 22 Adult members (21 years and over) will have access to grazing if available or as Club Committee sees fit.
- 23 Any breach of one or any of these terms and conditions, will at the discretion of the Club Committee lead to the termination of grazing rights on the Club grounds. (Two strikes and out with one weeks notice.)
- 24 There will be a maximum of one horse or pony per child riding member allowed. Any variance to this may be at the discretion of the committee and the grazing manager.
